

CCMGA RAZZ INFORMATION SHEET

The RAZZ is a weekly individual gross and net event played on Thursday mornings. It may be moved to another day of the week when a major holiday or a previously scheduled city tournament falls on Thursday. It may also be moved to another city course during Cave Creek's overseeding, or other maintenance work. Advance notice of any RAZZ schedule changes will be posted on our website, ccmga.net.

All current CCMGA members are eligible to participate in the RAZZ. A member may have one guest at each RAZZ. However, a guest may play only twice in a calendar year. Each guest must have a valid USGA handicap or play at scratch.

Tee times are based on a first come-first serve sign up held on the last Thursday of the month. At that time, members can sign up as individuals or as a single foursome for the upcoming month. Your completed RAZZ entry form must be initialed by the receiving staff. Any foursome that fails to show up for their scheduled tee time without advance notice to the pro shop, may, at the discretion of the RAZZ Committee, be refused entry in the next RAZZ.

Unless otherwise authorized by the RAZZ Committee, individual events will be played from the white tees.

The current entry fee is \$10 for the individual gross and net competition. Gross and net skins at \$5 each are optional. Event fees are paid in the Cave Creek Restaurant to the RAZZ Administrator. Green fees are paid in the Pro Shop.

All CCMGA members must compete in the RAZZ Hole-in-One Challenge for an entry fee of \$1.00. All funds will be held until an ace is formally recorded. Should more than one ace be made in a single tournament, the funds will be divided equally between all winners. All accumulated funds, including those collected the day an ace is recorded, will be paid out.

The event is flighted with the goal to have approximately 20 players in a flight. For example, if there are 120 players, there would probably be six flights. Flight sizes are equalized as much as possible, but all players with a given handicap are placed in the same flight. Handicap ranges within flights may vary from week to week based on the strength and size of the field. This means that a player may be in Flight D one week and Flight E the next depending on the field of players. Flight assignments will be determined at the conclusion of the event based on the handicaps of those who participated.

Gross and net prizes are paid equally within each flight based on the number of players in the flight. Flight winners will receive gift certificates. Skins winners will be paid in cash. Payouts are disbursed by the RAZZ Administrator the following Thursday.
